



## **Sports Physical Therapy Residency Program Fact Sheet**

### **I. Program Components**

#### ○ Faculty Composition

- Dr. Teresa Schuemann, PT, DPT, SCS, ATC developed EIM's Sports Residency and now serves as the Program Director. Dr. Schuemann is an experienced Program Director who has been Chair of the APTA Residency and Fellowship Credentialing Committee (which is now known as the APTA American Board of Residency and Fellowship Education.) Dr. Schuemann now serves as one of seven members on the APTA American Board of Residency and Fellowship Education.
- EIM's faculty are key contributors to the profession in academics/research & private practice.
- EIM principles and faculty have received multiple teaching, research and service awards including the American Physical Therapy Association's Eugene Michaels New Investigator Award, Jack Walker Research Award, Reviewer of the Year for the Physical Therapy Journal, Margaret Moore New Faculty Award, Orthopaedic Section's Rose Excellence in Research Award, American Academy of Orthopaedic Manual Physical Therapists' Excellence in Research Award, Kaltenborn Teach I Must Award, Texas Physical Therapy Association's Outstanding Physical Therapy Researcher Award, Ruby Decker Award and the William Gould Memorial Faculty Award.
- Faculty has served in numerous professional association positions such as President of the American Academy of Orthopaedic Manual Physical Therapists (AAOMPT), Treasurer of the AAOMPT and Secretary of the Sports Physical Therapy Section.
- Faculty has demonstrated success in private clinic start-up, expansion and team management.
- Faculty are heavily engaged at all levels of professional leadership, issue debate and clinic based care models.

#### ○ Curriculum

- 18 month program
- Core Didactics –5 core courses (8 weeks each) each including one live on site weekend intensive
- Topics in Sports PT – online perpetual interaction between students, fellowship advisors and faculty covering prepared coursework, case reviews, etc.
- Clinical Practicum – mentored practice by an EIM credentialed clinical mentor

## ○ Format

- Online format with robust curriculum - eliminates need to relocate and facilitates professional interaction among practitioners and faculty throughout the U.S. (and internationally)
- Hands-on, clinic-based weekend intensives at select (Network Partner and academic centers) locations throughout the U.S.
- Distributed mentoring with credentialed mentors and formal mentoring monitors and controls
- Formal collaborations with compatible providers throughout the U.S. (Network Partners) – NPs and academic centers provide the regional site for weekend intensives. EIM programs foster significant professional interaction, knowledge and skill development within each NP organization and enhance the NP's recruitment and retention efforts
- Formal collaboration with Focus On Therapeutic Outcomes (FOTO) for a customized EIM Clinical Tracking Log and Outcome Reporting System for the EIM Residency and Fellowship programs
